LFCA Board Meeting November 8, 2007

Bill reported a change in VA law regarding trees. Homeowners can now sue to force the removal of a tree, roots, or branches that represent a danger to the homeowners property. We are uncertain how this new law applies to this board.

Gloria reported that our landscape contractor will not replace the rotting timbers at our entrance. Gloria will look into alternatives. Gloria also reported that the smoking on Bertito has been resolved.

Bev gave an update on the "stucco house". The "for sale" sign is down. Our attorney has had no further response from Mr. Noorishad. At our attorney's request, the board prepared a statement of acceptable changes. This statement will be communicated to Mr. Noorishad via our attorney, after it has been reviewed by Al Brooks, chairman of the ARC committee. Mr. Noorishad needs to cover the stucco with an approved siding in a color, quality, and style consistent with the neighborhood. All changes must be approved by the ARC, prior to construction.
